- 3. Is the address listed on the petition your correct mailing address?
- 4. Did you personally sign the Petition, Schedules, Statements, and related documents?
- 5. Did you read the Petition, Schedules, Statements, and related documents before you signed them?
- 6. Are you personally familiar with the information contained in these documents?
- 7. To the best of your knowledge, is all that information true and correct?
- 8. Did you list all of your assets (everything you own)?
- 9. Did you list all of your creditors (everyone you owe money to)?
- 10. Are there any errors, omissions or changes that you need to make at this time?
- 11. Are there any creditors here with questions or objections?
- 12. Have you sold, given away, or transferred any property to a family member in the last six years?
- 13. Have you filed bankruptcy during the last 8 years?
- 14. What is the address of your current employer?
- 15. Is the copy of the tax return you provided an accurate copy of the most recent tax return you filed?
- 16. Have you filed all your required income tax returns for the last 4 years? If no, provide explanation.
- 17. Are you expecting any tax refund now?
- 18. Are you currently obligated to pay alimony or child support or any other Domestic Support Obligation? If yes:
 - a. For how many children, and what ages?
 - b. How long will your support obligation continue?
 - c. Are you current on your post-petition support payments?
